“Put Drugs & Bullies to Rest”

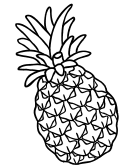
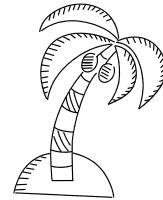
- Students may wear **PAJAMAS** with tennis shoes
