Our new name is a return to our roots Our school opened its doors in 1949 as Holy Family Catholic School. The school name was changed in 1976 when the parish became the first cathedral of the Diocese of Orange.

Today, the new landmark Christ Cathedral in Garden Grove is the new diocesan cathedral. So, as the parish returns to its roots and original name, so does the school.

Will the children need to buy new uniforms? No, students are not required to buy new uniforms just for the name change. Dennis Uniform has an inventory of uniforms with the old name, so invariably you will continue to see the old name.

It's okay to buy a uniform (used or new) with the old name. The new name will be gradually transitioned in with new inventory.

Holy Family Catholic School welcomed 225 students its first year (1949). Our first graduating class had 13 members.

The Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange were given charge of teaching at the school. Established in France, the Sisters of St. Joseph came to the US in 1836 and founded their Orange congregation in 1912.


