Mass Procedures for Inclement Weather

As we approach our winter, and with the current pandemic protocols, we want everyone to be informed of Holy Family Parish Mass procedures for inclement weather.

Inclement Weather Procedures

- All Masses will be live streamed
- Decision might be made at last minute – those at the church can live stream from their cars or drive home
- Communion will be distributed **up to 20 minutes AFTER each Mass at WALK UP Behind the Sacristy**
 - Together in Prayer volunteers will be on site to direct parishioners
 - Parishioners will park cars and walk up to receive Communion
 - Face masks must be worn, they can be removed to receive Communion and must be put back on after for walk back to car
 - Social distancing will be adhered to
 - Hand sanitizers will be out for use
- Communion for physically challenged will be brought to your cars parked in the handicap parking
- Baskets will be out at the back of the Sacristy for contributions

Wearing Masks to Control the Spread of COVID-19

People age 2 and older should wear masks in public settings and when around people who don't live in their household. Masks offer some protection to you and are also meant to protect those around you, in case you have COVID-19, but don't know it. A mask is NOT a substitute for social distancing and should still be worn in addition to staying at least 6 feet apart from others. However, masks may not be necessary when you are outside by yourself away from others, or with other people who live in your household.
