

Dear Parents,

Yesterday, the California Department of Public Health revised its guidelines on face coverings. In addition to face coverings being required to be worn at all times when outside of the home, children age 3 and older are now required to wear face coverings.

- Effective tomorrow, **Thursday**, **November 19<sup>th</sup>**, all students in preschool through 8<sup>th</sup> grade are required to wear face coverings.
- Please send an extra one or two in a baggie for the younger children especially, and please talk to your child about the proper way to wear the face covering. The teachers will also reinforce proper care of the face coverings. Attached are the guidelines that were sent to us by the California Department of Public Health.

With the holidays fast approaching and many families planning vacations, here is a reminder of what constitutes a Remote Learner and how to proceed with make-up work for those students who miss school:

- Remote Learning is a trimester long commitment, unless a parent has previously made arrangements with the school to have their student return to campus prior to the end of the trimester. Students may not move back and forth between Remote an in-person within a trimester.
- Any student who is enrolled in *in-person instruction* and does not attend school for any reason other than whole class quarantine, **does not shift into Remote Learning**, but uses Google Classroom to get assignments and make up work. Those who do not attend school while enrolled in in-person instruction are marked absent and follow the absence protocols.
