Thursday, Oct. 29

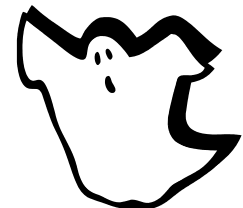
“PUT DRUGS & BULLIES TO REST”
